QUESTIONS REGARDING 17ITB012417-DRR, CLARK COMMUNITY PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT:

- 1) The only question that I have on this project is the Poured-N-Place surfacing. When looking at the industry standards that have been published in your specifications there are 2 different types. One is called EPDM which is very tightly bonded surfacing and very smooth to the touch. It's typically used where there is heavy traffic, school systems and military bases. The colors are very bold and bright which makes for extra colors on the playground. The second one is recycled bonded rubber which is less expensive, not bonded that tightly and over time can become separated from the surfacing mainly because the larger pieces are bonded together. This is a very common problem with this type of surfacing and the colors for this product are limited to natural colors.

Response: Yes, the City will add both options for Contractors to supply a response for the two (2) different types of poured-n-place surfacing. See the attached UPDATED BID PRICING form.

- 2) Do you have the 2-D and 3-D drawings of the specified playground equipment, so we can match our playground equipment to what is specified?

Response: No. The City does not have drawings of the specified playground equipment; however, all of the items on pricing sheet that the City used in the specifications came from PlayWorld Inc. products line.

- 3) What is the budget for the playground equipment including installation and surfacing and is the funding in place

Response: Based on the Contractors bid submittal; Funding has been appropriated accordingly for this project.

- 4) Will the site be prepared (graded, drainage, etc.)

Response: The existing surface is flat, minor grading if any.

- 5) Will there be an opportunity to view the site

Response: The site visit was held on February 15, 2017 at 10AM.

- 6) How big is the playground site (dimensions)

Response: The size of the playground should be similar to the size of the playground at the Memorial Park playground.

7) What type of safety surface do you want (wood fiber, poured in place, etc)

Response: Surface shall be Poured In Place, and final surface elevation shall be no more than three (3") inches above existing grade.

8) What age groups will be using the playground

Response: For all ages and all abilities.

9) What type of equipment are you looking for (climbing, spinning, rocking, etc.)

Response: See Bid Pricing Form for equipment specifications.

10) Do all pieces need to be ADA or a mixture

Response: Yes, all of the equipment must be ADA equipment no exceptions.

11) What is the decision/selection criteria, how will you pick the partner

Response: Responsiveness, and responsibility of the Contractor, along with overall price, design, references, quality of materials and layout.

12) What is the timeframe for project award and when do you want the playground installed

Response: Project anticipation for an award April 3, 2017; project installation is for May 2017.

13) Is there a design committee we can meet with prior to the bid to make sure our submittal addresses their needs and concerns

Response: Yes, after the execution of the contract the Contractor will have the opportunity to review the site along with the City Manager or his designee before any work will begin.
