RESOLUTION NO. R16-752

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SEASONAL HOLIDAY JOB FAIR AT  
THE MERLE MANDERS CONFERENCE CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds;

WHEREAS, Section 1.12(b)(41) of the City Charter, the City is vested with certain broad powers "to exercise and enjoy all other powers, functions, rights, privileges, and immunities necessary or desirable to promote or protect the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience, or general welfare of the city and its inhabitants;"

WHEREAS, Section 1.12(b) of the City Charter states that "the powers of this city shall be construed liberally in favor of the city. The specific mention or failure to mention particular powers shall not be construed as limiting in any way the powers of this city;"

WHEREAS, the City desires to conduct a seasonal holiday job fair for people who are residents of the City of Stockbridge;

WHEREAS, the City specifically finds that the proposed seasonal holiday job fair promotes and protects the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the city and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believe that the seasonal holiday job fair is in the best interest of the City and its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1.     **Authorization** – The Mayor and Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby authorize a seasonal holiday job fair to occur on October 6, 2016 at the Merle Manders Conference Center.

Section 2.     **Documents** – The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.


Section 3.     **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the date of its adoption by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
