RESOLUTION NO. R16-754

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGETED PAY INCREASES FOR
THE CITY MANAGER, CITY CLERK AND TREASURER**

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds;

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the city council shall provide for the compensation of the City Manager, City Clerk and Treasurer;

WHEREAS, in adopting the FY-2016 budget for the City, certain annual salary increases were provided for all city employees including the City Manager, City Clerk and Treasurer;

WHEREAS, it was the intent of the City Council that such increases would routinely apply to the City Manager, City Clerk and Treasurer on the anniversary of their respective dates of employment with the City;

WHEREAS, the City specifically finds that the proposed increases promote and protect the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the city and its inhabitants by maintaining a highly qualified city staff;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believe that the budgeted salary increases are in the best interest of the City and its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1. **Authorization** – The Mayor and Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby authorizes those salary increases budgeted for in the FY-2016 budget for the City Manager, City Clerk and Treasurer and that such increases are to be effective as of the annual anniversary date of each person's date of employment.

Section 2. **Documents** – The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the date of its adoption by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
