ORDINANCE 2014-OR 14-346

AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT THE CITY CLERK POSITION

WHEREAS, The City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4.13 of the City Charter states that the City Clerk shall serve as the custodian of the official City seal, maintain City Council records, and perform such other duties as may be required by the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, the appointee shall perform the duties of the Clerk directly or supervise others under his/her supervision if approved by the City Council, and notwithstanding any delegation of duties, the appointee shall remain responsible for the duties assigned to him/her by the City Council and in accordance with the City Charter; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint Ms. Stephanie Tigner as the City Clerk, to be compensated at an annual rate of \$ _____ per year, subject to any amendments enacted by the Council; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Stockbridge, the following:

Section 1: Approval: The City Council of the City of Stockbridge, pursuant to its authority under Section 4.14 of the City Charter, hereby appoints Stephanie Tigner as the City Clerk of the City of Stockbridge, with an annual compensation of \$ 60,736.80 per year.

Section 2: Approval of Execution: The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this ordinance on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and to seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: Severability: To the extent any portion of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions: All City ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.


