ORDINANCE 2014- 14-349

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
SECTION 4.10 DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge "City" is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.10 of the City Charter states that the city council by ordinance shall prescribe the functions or duties and establish, abolish, or alter all non-elective offices, positions of employment, departments and agencies of the city as necessary for the proper administration of the affairs and government of this city.

WHEREAS, the City council desires to amend the Ordinance, No. 13-328 to include two additional departments, Administration and Community Service, and the Main Street Department.

NOW, THEREFORE The Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby ordains, the following:

Section 1: Approval: The City Council of the City of Stockbridge, Pursuant to its authority under Section 4.10 of the City Charter, hereby shall amend Ordinance. No. 13-328 Section 1, 8-12-2013, to include the following Departments Of which each department shall have a department head/and or director:

- A. Administrative;
- B. Public works;
- C. Administration and Community Service
- D. Main Street
- E. Police Department
- F. Finance

It is the intent of the Council that Department head and Director have the same meaning.

Section 2: Approval of Execution: The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this ordinance on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and to seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: Severability: To the extent any portion of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.


Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions: All City ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.




