

RESOLUTION NO. R15637

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND OUR CURRENT SECURITY LIGHT CONTRACT WITH SNAPPING SHOALS EMC, TO PROVIDE LIGHTING IN THE SUMMIT AT EAGLES LANDING SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds, and

WHEREAS, THE City of Stockbridge has an existing contract with Snapping Shoals EMC which was signed by the City in 2012, to provide power to a total of Forty-One (41) street lights at a cost of \$504.00/month; and,

WHEREAS, an additional ten (10) street lights are already installed in the subdivision, however, they have not yet been activated because the contract had not been amended, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of this community have asked that the City amend our contract with Snapping Shoals EMC for the purpose of having the additional ten (10) lights activated; and

NOW therefore be it resolved, the Stockbridge City Council agrees to amend the Security Light Contract, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the required documents, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

SECTION 1. Public Record. This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City of Stockbridge.

SECTION 2. Approval of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. Attestation. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Stockbridge as provided in the City Charter.

SECURITY LIGHT CONTRACT

I, City of Stockbridge, the undersigned, being a member of Snapping Shoals Electric Membership Corporation (here-in-after called the Cooperative), do hereby request the installation of security light facilities as listed below. I understand that this service is provided under Schedule "OL" of the Cooperative's service rates as approved by the Cooperative's Board of Directors. The rates and charges indicated below reflect the current charges for these services under the current rate schedule and are subject to change from time to time, including during the initial term of this contract. Further, this service is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Service will be rendered only at locations that, solely in the opinion of the Cooperative, are readily accessible for installation and maintenance.
2. Service includes normal maintenance (fixture, lamp, photocell, pole, wire) and energy usage of fixture. Members may be required to reimburse the Cooperative for damages caused by vandalism.
3. Wood pole height at discretion of SSEMC engineers.
4. Payments required herein do not constitute ownership of any facilities by the member. The Cooperative retains full ownership of lights, poles, wiring, etc..

Members metered service may be subject to disconnection of terms and conditions of this contract are not met.

5. In the event that, in the sole opinion of Snapping Shoals EMC, excessive rock is encountered during the installation of underground service cables, the owner shall be responsible for the removal of said excessive rock.

6. During installation of facilities, it may be necessary to install conduit and wire under future paved surfaces. The customer shall be responsible for soil compaction after SSEMC has completed the installation.

7. In the event it is necessary to cut the pavement for repair of facilities after installation, SSEMC shall compact the soil to 95% compaction and the owner shall complete patching of pavement.

CONTRACT TERM: The initial term of this contract shall be for 12 months and shall be automatically renewed unless canceled upon thirty days written notice.


