

RESOLUTION NO. R14-617

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND OUR CURRENT SECURITY LIGHT CONTRACT  
WITH SNAPPING SHOALS EMC, TO PROVIDE LIGHTING IN THE CLARK  
MEADOWS SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds, and

WHEREAS, THE City of Stockbridge has an existing contract with Snapping Shoals EMC which was signed by the City in 2007, to provide power to seventeen (17) street lights at a cost of \$204.00/month; and,

WHEREAS, an additional nineteen (19) are already installed in the subdivision, however, they have not yet been activated because the contract had not been amended, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of this community have asked that the City amend our contract with Snapping Shoals EMC for the purpose of having the additional nineteen (19) lights activated; and

NOW therefore be it resolved, the Stockbridge City Council agrees to amend the Security Light Contract, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the required documents, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

**SECTION 1. Public Record.** This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City of Stockbridge.

**SECTION 2. Approval of Execution.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.






